## Trefoil Guild Life Membership

- A Guild may apply for Life Membership on behalf of their member/s by notifying the State Trefoil Guild Adviser on form ATG 6/12. *Updated 2015*
- The State Trefoil Guild Adviser will contact the Guild to ask how they wish to proceed with the presentation and arrange for the Australian Trefoil Guild National certificate/s to be available.
- The Guild undertakes to pay membership for each life member, and must pay membership for each life member annually.
- Life Membership does not extend beyond that Guild. Should the Life Member leave, transfer, or the Guild close, the life membership is cancelled.

## Trefoil Guild Honorary Membership

A Guild member may find that, due to age or on-going ill health, she is no longer able to regularly and actively attend Guild meetings and events. Honorary Membership conveys the intention of current members of that Trefoil Guild to maintain contact and to include the Honorary Member in special events if practical.

- A Trefoil Guild may award Honorary Membership to such a member in appreciation of her past contribution.
- An Honorary Member **is not** eligible to accrue long service as no membership fee is paid.
- No fee is payable.
- Honorary Members do not vote.
- Honorary Members are not covered by insurance.
